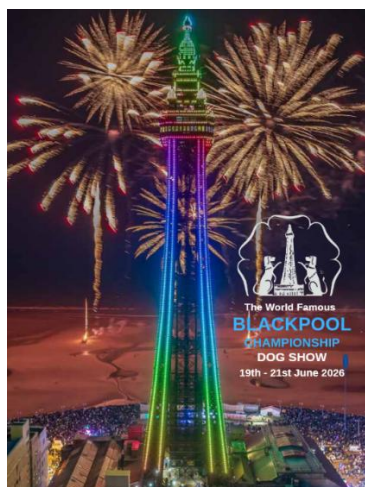

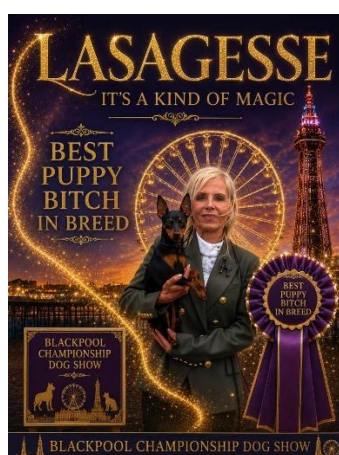

Judges critique : Scott Toney – Midwood

It was an absolute pleasure to judge at this special event. My sincere thanks to Steve Hall and the entire show committee for their kind invitation and exceptional hospitality. The show grounds were immaculate, with beautifully maintained and meticulously groomed grass. The exhibitors had access to a wide variety of food, refreshments, and canine vendors at the venue. We were fortunate to avoid rain and although there were occasional gusts of wind, the weather was warm and pleasant with a mix of sunshine and clouds. I was especially impressed by the overall quality of the dogs presented to me and was equally pleased by the outstanding sportsmanship exhibited by everyone throughout the day. It was a thoroughly enjoyable assignment from beginning to end. If you have not had the opportunity to attend this show, I highly recommend adding it to your calendar in the future.

English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan)

I enjoyed every minute of judging this breed, and very much appreciated the outstanding temperament on display. As a dog whose original purpose was that of a ratter, I was happy to see outgoing, game temperaments with no signs of nervousness despite the gusting winds and large dogs in rings nearby. I was pleased to see that most had the characteristic wedge-shaped head and powerful jaws so important in this breed. A couple of exhibits were a bit too tucked up at the loin and one or two carried their tails too high, but overall, a very high-quality entry. The exhibitors were exceedingly good sports, and there was a high sense of camaraderie present in the ring.

Class 128. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Puppy Dog

Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1st 371 - Etruria I Say (Mrs Sj Dean-Armitt) – This puppy was a perfect size with its Terrier origins evident, but every bit a toy. Lovely rise over the loin, proper tail set, and wedge-shaped head. I would like to see more rear angulation. Best Puppy.

2ND 384 - Ettology Stand and Deliver of Pendlethrine (Mrs C Pendlebury) – It was evident this owner trained its puppy to perfection. It did everything asked of it with great poise. I appreciated the properly shaped ears and correct tail set. Needed more rear drive on the move.

Class 1 29. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) – Junior Dog

1ST 373 - Am Ch Cottage Lakes Lasagesse American Pie (Imp Usa) (Mr G & Mrs L Dixon) – Another exhibit of perfect size. I very much appreciated not only his compact body, but also how proportionate he is. Very nice rear angles and pretty candle flame ears. Good pigment with well-defined lines. I would like to see a bit more shoulder layback. Best Junior.

Class 130. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Limit Dog

1ST 383 - Ettology Small Gods of Pendlethrine (Mrs C Pendlebury) – Correctly marked with rich, vivid pigment and clearly defined lines of color division. Sound, flowing drive with good rear action, and enjoyed his time in the ring. Would prefer a stronger underjaw.

Class 131. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Open Dog

1ST 387 - Witchstone Silent Wish with Rahima JW ShCEx OSW (Miss C Roskell) - This exhibit was displayed the alert and game temperament you'd expect with his terrier heritage but also possessed the elegance and size of a true toy dog. Perfect tail set and carriage. Trained to perfection, and one of the best silhouettes of the day with curves in all the right places. Best Dog.

2ND 381 - Witchstone Follow The Dream with Tettoy (Mrs V Love) – Another dog that loves to move out and show off his sound, flowing, and precise movement. Marked beautifully with clearly defined colorlines. Sound legs with good angulation in rear. At times did not display enough curve from shoulder to loin. Reserve Best Dog.

3RD 369 - Edalene in A Silent Way to Capledrae JW (Mr R &; Mrs M Bennett)

Class 132. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Veteran Dog

1ST 370 - Ch Witchstone Place Your Bets at Capledrae JW ShCEx OSW VW (Mr R &; Mrs M Bennett) – At the larger end of the standard, but very sound with straight front legs, elbows close to chest, and good turn of stifle. Very pretty in profile and correct wedge-shaped head. Looking very game and spry as a veteran.

Class 133. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Special Beginners

1ST 368 - Grayswish Time of My Life (Miss C Attfield) – I appreciated the sound and stylish movement on this bitch; good extended trot with flowing quality. Very good tail, thick at root and tapering to a point. Ears could be broader at base. Best Special Beginner.

2ND 382 - Regalriver Big Bad She Wolf (Mrs C Marsden) – In lovely condition and weight with well sprung ribs and rounding correctly at buttocks. Vivid ebony black and chestnut tan. Dainty, compact feet, but a little weak at pasterns.

Class 134. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Puppy Bitch

1ST 385 - Lasagesse A Kind of Magic of Pendlethrine (Mrs C Pendlebury) – Loved seeing the terrier heritage reflected in this bitch's strong, powerful jaws and large white teeth. Very sound and showy. Did her owner proud.

2ND 388 - Sharex Dragons Black Opium (Mrs K J & Miss C E Williams) – This is a bitch that has so many great qualities; fantastic breed type with correct markings, a lovely topline curving from behind the shoulders to loin. Some of the prettiest ears of the day that were erect, placed high on skull, and with thin leather. She was distracted on the move.

Class 135. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Junior Bitch

1ST 382 - Regalriver Big Bad She Wolf (Mrs C Marsden) – Same comments as above.

Class 136. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Limit Bitch

Entries: 4 Absentees: 1

1ST 379 - Spawood Miss Molly (Mr M B Jones) – A larger bitch that uses every bit of herself on the move. A pleasure to watch her flow around the ring. Complete and strong scissors bite. Slightly arched neck with well laid-back shoulders.

2ND 386 - Wykewoks Autumnal Sunsetta of Pendlethrine (Mrs C Pendlebury) – Smaller sized bitch but still showing a lovely wedge-shaped head with strong bite. Fantastic pigment. A little low at withers.

3RD 382 - Regalriver Big Bad She Wolf (Mrs C Marsden)

Class 137. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Open Bitch

Entries: 4 Absentees: 1

1ST 374 - Ch Lasagesse Kashmir JW (Mr G & Mrs L Dixon) – An impressive bitch in every regard and a true joy to judge. Very strong not just in soundness but also breed type. Moved correctly and with great confidence with the low set tail carried at the perfect level. Fine boned with dainty, compact feet. Happy to award her a well-deserved Best Bitch and Best of Breed.

2ND 389 - Lady in Black at Witchstone (Mr J & Mr A Wood & Leonard) – Very similar in many regards to the winner of this class, and a lovely bitch in every regard. The only thing that held her back on the day is she displayed a bit less confidence and purpose on the move as the first-place bitch.

3RD 380 - Lasagesse Whole Lotta Love with Tettoy JW (Mrs V Love)

Class 138. English Toy Terrier (Black and Tan) - Veteran Bitch.

1ST 377 - Edalene Never Let Me Go VW (Mrs C & Miss R Inch) – Seeing this owner and glorious bitch work in tandem was one of the highlights of my day.
